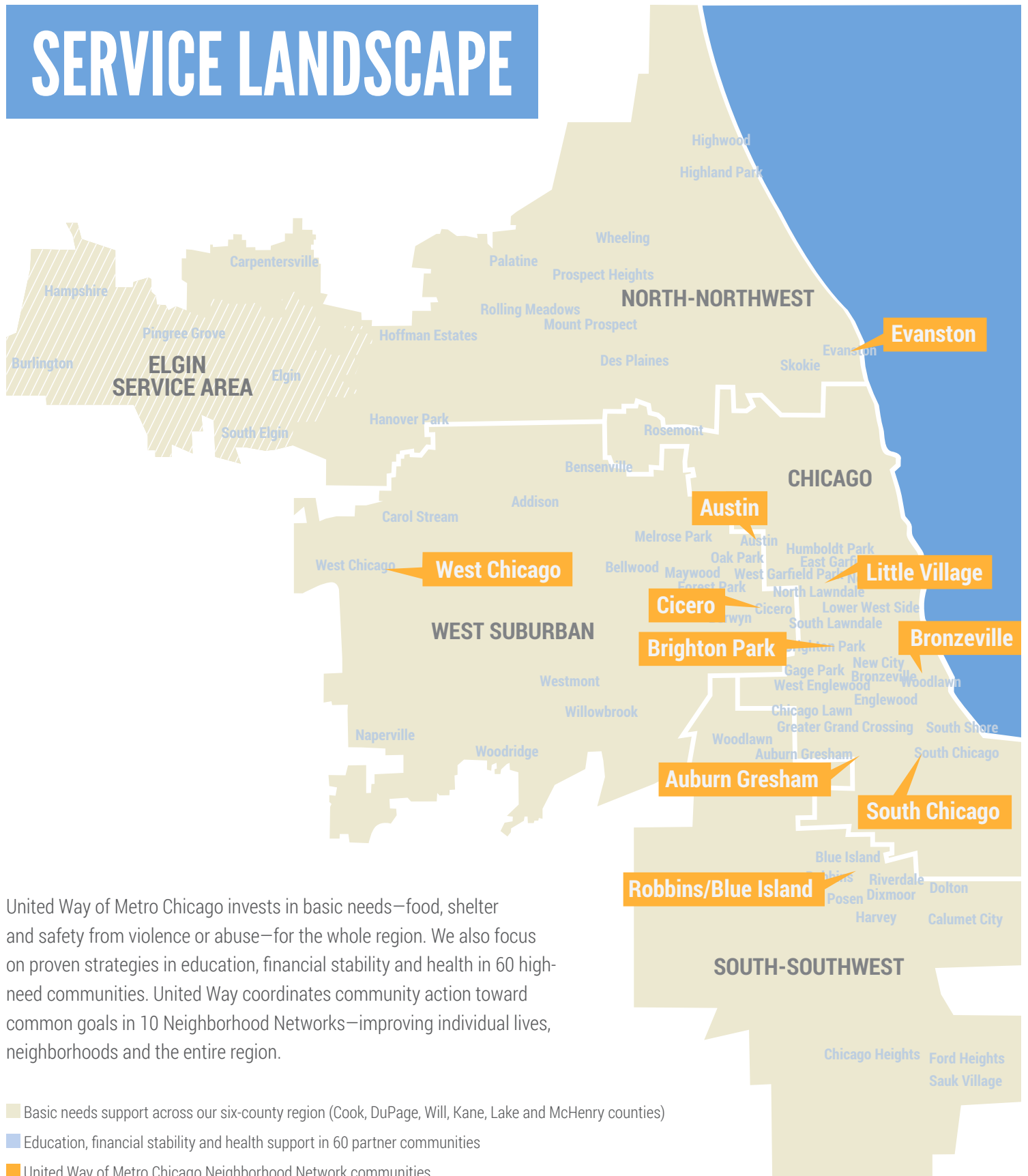


SERVICE LANDSCAPE
